#### Euro-NATO Joint Jet Pilot Training Program Positively Impacts Community

Each graduating class from the <u>Euro-NATO Joint Jet Pilot Training Program</u> (ENJJPT) takes it upon themselves to complete a volunteer project in our local community. This initiative turned out to be great news for two members of the Wichita Falls Chamber over the last two months: <u>Wichita Falls Food Bank</u> and <u>Child Care Partners</u>.

Class 23-06, which graduated in June, helped to process over 5,000 pounds of donated food items at the Wichita Falls Food Bank.

Class 23-07, which just graduated at the end of July, committed 33 hours to cleaning, sorting, and organizing over 2,000 pounds of donated clothing and home goods in support of Child Care Partners.

#### International Partner of the Month: Qatar

This week, our exploration of <u>Qatar</u> focuses on the Qatar Armed Forces (QAF). The QAF is made up of the Qatari Amiri Land Force, Qatari Amiri Navy and Qatari Amiri Air Force. Conscription was introduced in 2013 for men aged 18 to 35, with required service time ranging from four to 12 months. Women have been able to volunteer for service since 2018. Qatar "has Major Non-NATO Ally status with the U.S., a designation under U.S. law that provides foreign partners with certain benefits in the areas of defense trade and security cooperation." Qatar is also home to the "regional headquarters for the U.S. Central Command and more than 8,000 U.S. military forces at various military facilities, including the large Al Udeid Air Base."
